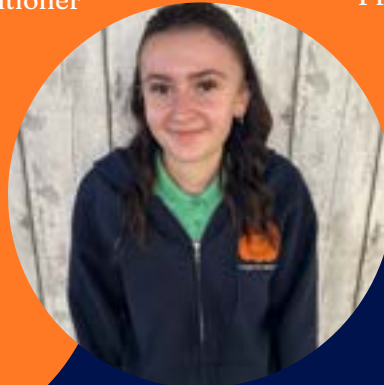

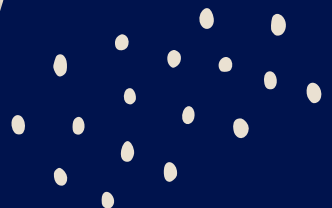

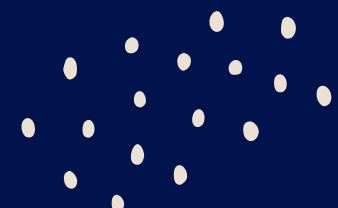

Welcome to Preschool



Our preschoolers have the biggest space in nursery, benefitting from an upper and lower preschool which allows us to support their development from being an almost three year old, through to starting school. Lead by qualified teaching staff, it is rare for our preschoolers to leave us before starting reception and we are always so proud of the achievements that they make during their time with us. As well as helping them with early maths, sound recognition and early literacy skills, we also focus on developing independence, confidence and the ability to express themselves to peers and adults.
